## The ETUI-REHS documentation centre

holds a unique collection of literature covering the fields of European and international industrial relations, social and economic issues and occupational health and safety. An important part of the literature covers contemporary and historical aspects of European and international trade unionism. The documentation centre has built up this collection over almost 40 years of existence. More than 19,000 publications and over 200 specialist periodicals are available for consultation.

**The centre is widely** used by academics, researchers, trade unionists and university students. It offers reading and working facilities in an attractive and comfortable environment. The documentalists are on hand to provide professional search assistance and information services.

**Labourline** is the on-line catalogue of the ETUI-REHS documentation centre. The database is enriched every day. An increasing number of references provide a link to downloadable documents. This database provides access to more than 42,000 bibliographical references (books, articles, technical standards, AV material) of relevance to the world of labour.
